Silver Evening Bag

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Silver Evening Bag was designed by knitvana.com

The size of the bag is $7.5'' \times 4'' \times 2''$. We used Patons Brilliant silver yarn for the external part of the bag and white cotton yarn (Sugar N Cream or mill ends sold by pound in A.C. Moore) for the lining.

We knitted the bag with bamboo needles #0 (2 mm) and #2 (3 mm).




Front, Back and Lining (1 detail)

- •Cast on 25 stitches using silver yarn (1 thread) and needles #2. You will start with 6" and rounded corners will add 3/4" each for the total width of 7.5".
- Make rounded corners by adding stitches on both ends.
- •Row 1: (1K, 1P)*.
- •Row 2: Knit 1; add 1 stitch; (1K, 1P)*; add 1 stitch at the end of the row.
- •Row 3: Knit 1; add 1 stitch; (1P, 1K)*; add 1 stitch at the end of the row.
- •Row 4: (1K, 1P)*.
- •Rows 5: Knit 1; add 1 stitch; (1K, 1P)*; add 1 stitch at the end of the row.
- •Row 6: (1P, 1K)*.
- •Row 7: Knit 1; add 1 stitch; (1P, 1K)*; add 1 stitch at the end of the row.
- •Row 8: (1K, 1P)*.
- •Row 9: Knit 1; add 1 stitch; (1K, 1P)*; add 1 stitch at the end of the row.
- •Row 10,11: (1P, 1K)*.
- •Row 12: Knit 1; add 1 stitch; (1P, 1K)*; add 1 stitch at the end of the row. You will have the total of 37 stitches.
- •Rows 13-26: (1K, 1P)*. Switch to needles #0 (2 mm).
- •Row 27, 29, 31: All knit.
- •Rows 28, 30, 32: All Perl
- •Row 33: All Perl
- •Rows 34, 36, 38: All Perl
- •Rows 35, 37, 39: All Knit.
- •Switch to white cotton yarn and needles #2 to knit the lining.

Front, Back and Lining (cont.)

- While knitting the lining: all odd rows: all Knit; all even rows: all Perl. Knit 14 rows (rows 40-53).
- •Even Row 54-64: Perl 1; 2Ptog; All Perl; 2Ptog at the end of the row.
- •Odd Row 55-65: All Knit
- •Even Row 66-78: Perl 1; Add 1 stitch; All Perl; Add 1 stitch at the end of the row.
- •Odd Rows 67-77: All Knit.
- Switch to silver yarn and needles #0.
- •Row 79, 81, 83: All knit.
- •Rows 80, 82, 84: All Perl
- •Row 85: All Perl
- •Rows 86, 88, 90: All Perl
- Rows 87, 89, 91: All Knit. Switch to needles #2.
- •Rows 92-105: (1K, 1P)*.
- •Row 106: Knit 1; K2tog; (1K, 1P)*; K2tog at the end of the row.
- •Row 107, 108: (1P, 1K)*.
- •Row 109: Knit 1; K2tog;; (1P, 1K)*; K2tog at the end of the row.
- •Row 110: (1K, 1P)*.
- •Row 111: Knit 1; K2tog; (1K, 1P)*; K2tog at the end of the row.
- •Row 112: (1P, 1K)*.
- •Row 113: Knit 1; K2tog;; (1P, 1K)*; K2tog at the end of the row.
- •Row 114: (1K, 1P)*.
- •Row 115: Knit 1; K2tog; (1K, 1P)*; K2tog at the end of the row.
- •Row 116: Knit 1; K2tog;; (1P, 1K)*; K2tog at the end of the row.
- •Row 117: (1K, 1P)*.
- Close all.





Bottom and Sides (2 details)

- •The bottom should hold the shape of the bag thus it needs to be thick. We used 2 threads and needles #2.
- Cast on 11 stitches.
- •All rows: all Knits. Knit 4" then start reducing stitches. Make sure you knitted enough to cover the bottom and rounded corners.
- •Gradually reduce the number of stitches by knitting 2 stitches together.
- •Sew 2 details together on the bottom.

Handles (2 details)

- •Cast on 6 stitches using silver yarn (1 thread) and needles #0.
- •All Rows: (1P, 1K)*
- •Knit handles 11' long.
- •Sew all parts together.
